

# Environmental Management Policy Statement

Belfast International Airport is aware of its responsibility to the environment and is committed to monitoring, managing and seeking to continually improve its environmental performance.

The company commits to:

- Ensure that Belfast International Airport meets all environmental legislative requirements as a minimum, and exceeds these wherever possible
- Seek to protect the environment, prevent pollution and minimise the use of natural resources (energy, fuel and water) and raw materials (paper and other consumables) wherever possible
- Minimise the generation of waste from our activities through encouraging re-use and recycling
- Recycle redundant items into the community whenever feasible
- Ensure that waste for disposal is treated in an environmentally sensitive manner
- Maintain plant, equipment and buildings for maximum safety, efficiency in the use of materials, natural resources and services and avoidance of environmentally damaging emissions
- Adopt other energy efficient practices wherever possible
- Whenever possible and without prejudice to the business, to use suppliers and pursue clients having similar policies and practices
- Raise and maintain the awareness of employees about environmental issues
- Encourage employees to participate in initiatives that support the statement

## Business Rules for Environment

All employees must recognise that they have an important part to play by:

- Taking care to minimise their own use of resources and consumables, including paper, utilities and travel, and preventing unnecessary use whenever possible
- Switching off all non-essential equipment when not in use
- Co-operating with Belfast International Airport management in all aspects of environmental management
- Considering how to minimise the environmental impact of their own business activities and the use of environmentally friendly options wherever possible.
